Welcome to the third annual Woods and Meadow Side by Side Classic! We are excited to host this shoot again and look forward to welcoming new and old faces to our range.

MAIN EVENT

The main event will take place Friday and Saturday and consists of an 80-target Sporting Clays, 80-target Upland Double Flush, 30-target 5-stand, and 30-target Pigeon Ring. The main event will be squadded and must be shot with a side by side. For each main event, scores will be ordered from highest to lowest. Shooters will receive a rank (i.e. 5th, 31st, 122nd) for each event. Each individual's rankings will be added up across the 4 main events. The shooter with the lowest total ranking (closest to 1) will be the main event HOA and will be awarded the HOA belt buckle! Lewis class will also be available for entry.

REGISTRATION

The main event will be limited to 120 entrants. Please fill out the registration form, one per squad member (5 in a squad max), and send with payment to Woods and Meadow. Please find the registration form on our website: woodsandmeadow.com



THURSDAY OPEN SHOOTING

The **Sporting Clays** course will be open from 8am till last squad out at 4pm. Participants can take a count up card and shoot as much as they want. The cost will be on a per-target basis. Thursday sporting clays can be shot with any type of gun and will be open to the public as well.

The **Pheasant Challenge** 5-stand will not have a menu (trapper's choice) and can be shot as many times as desired, with the highest score counting for the competition. The entrant with the highest score will win a 10-pheasant hunt. This event is only offered on Thursday, as the traps will be changed afterward for the main event. The Pheasant Challenge must be shot with a side by side in order to count for score.

The **All Bore** course (30 targets) will be open Thursday through Saturday and can be shot for score. The All Bore can be shot as many times as you want with any bore. Each individual's highest score per bore will count for the competition. The All Bore must be shot with a side by side in order to count for score.

NEW The **Maker's Challenge** course (30 targets, separate course) will be open Thursday through Saturday and can be shot for score. It can be shot as many times as you want with any make, with the highest score per make counting for the competition. The Maker's Challenge must be shot with a side by side in order to count for score. Competition will be head-to-head regardless of bore (no handicaps). Awards will only be given to makers in which at least 4 people have entered.

NEW The **2-Man Duck Flurry** will be open Thursday and Friday. More details to follow.

MAKE-A-BREAK

Make-a-Break will be offered as a side event on Friday and Saturday. This event includes 24 targets, two competitors, and must be shot with a side by side and there are no handicaps for gauge. It can be shot as many times as desired and the highest score counts for the competition. Rules to follow.

GOLF CARTS

The sporting clays course is just over a mile. Golf cart rentals are available and need to be reserved and paid for in advance with the registration form. We will be offering 2-seaters for \$150 and 4-seaters for \$255. Rentals are for all 3 days. We have very few 4-seaters available, but 2-seaters are unlimited. Otherwise, entrants are encouraged to bring their own golf cart, ATV, or UTV.

LODGING

Onsite dry camping is available. There is plenty of space, so no need to make reservations. Alternatively, Black River Falls and Tomah have many hotels within half an hour from Woods and Meadow. The Holiday Inn and Hampton Inn in Tomah both have special rates for Woods and Meadow customers. The Three Bears Resort and various Airbnb's in Warrens are good options as well, and are about 10 minutes away.

FOOD

A simple lunch will be available for purchase Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Saturday night dinner will be catered and will consist of broasted chicken and sides. Saturday dinner is \$18 and must be paid for in advance with registration.

VENDORS

Vendors are more than welcome Thursday through Saturday. Our enclosed shop area will be laid out with fold-up tables where vendors can put items for sale. If you need a larger space, like a pop-up tent, please let us know in advance and we can accommodate. There is no vendor fee! Call 608-378-4223 with questions.

AWARD CATEGORIES

The awards ceremony will promptly follow Saturday night dinner. Door prizes will be in the form of cash and will be awarded to every 1 out of 10 entrants in the main event. You do not need to be present to win door prizes!

All event awards will be paid out with cash (unless otherwise stated).

Main Event HOA and High Gun in each of the 4 individual main event categories will receive a belt buckle and cash. The All Bore award categories include HOA in 10 ga, 12 ga, 16 ga, 20 ga, 28 ga, .410, and hammer gun (must have at least 3 entrants in a bore for an award). Maker's Challenge awards will be given to HOA in each gun maker category (must have at least 4 entrants in a category to count for awards). There will also be awards for HOA Pheasant Challenge (10-pheasant hunt), HOA 2-Man Duck Flurry, and 1st, 2nd, 3rd for Make-a-Break.
